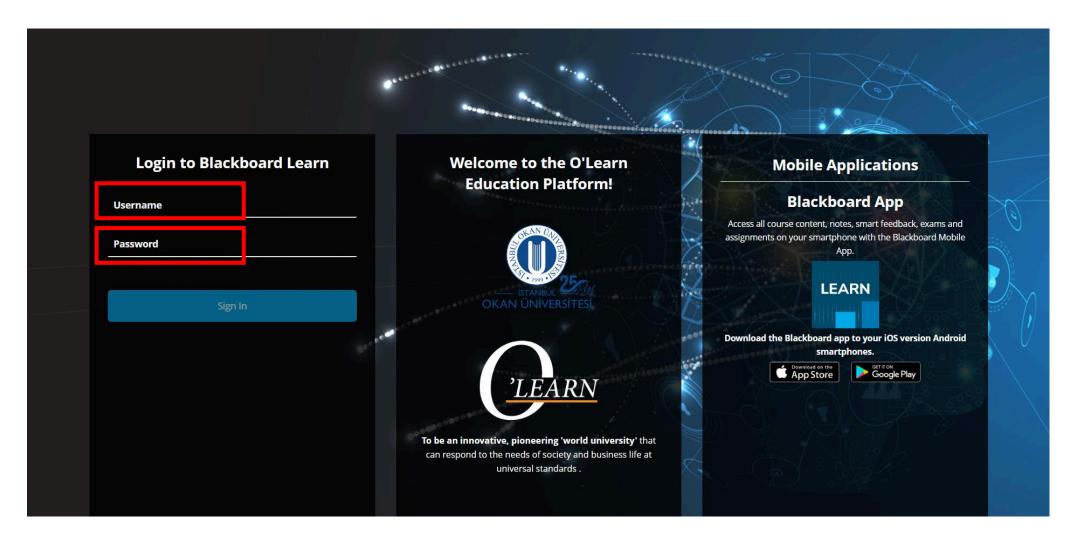

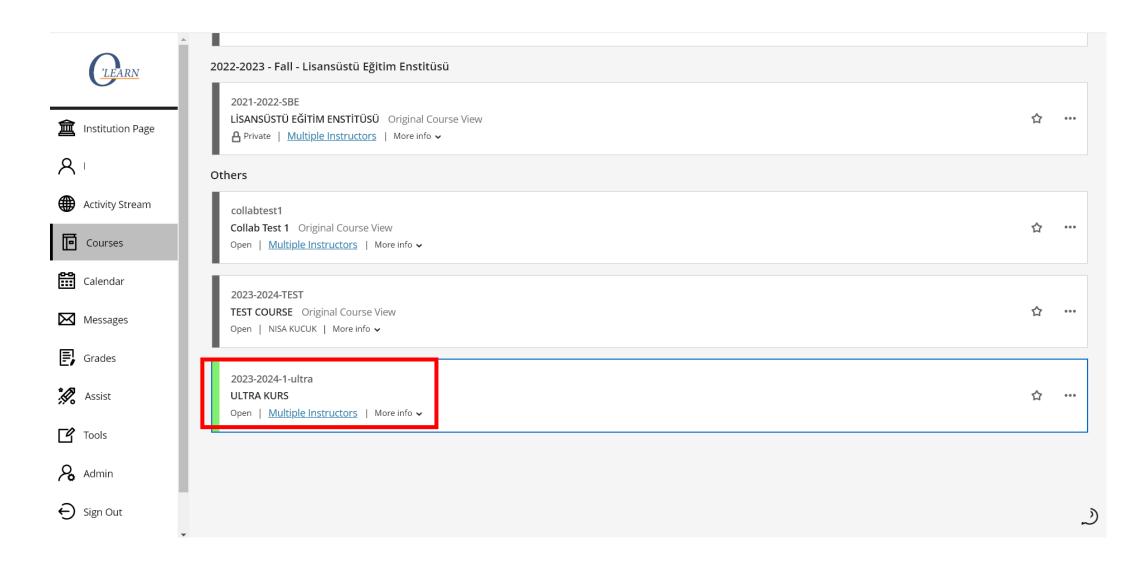
How Can I Automatically Generate Exam Questions?




Log in using the Chrome, Microsoft Edge browser.

Access the platform at https://olearn.okan.edu.tr/


Log in to the O'Learn platform with your OIS (Student Information System) username and password.




Log in to the course from the courses link.




Click the **Create** option in the marked area.




In the window that opens, click the **Test** option.



You can start question generation with **Al-supported Automatic-generate question** option from the test creation panel.



- •Enter a description (up to 2,000 characters).
- •Set the complexity level of the questions.
- •Select the number of questions.
- Change the output language from the Advance Options section.
- •Click Select Course Items to use specific course materials as context to support the content of the questions.




You can choose from different question types.

Include it in your test by clicking **Add to Assessment**.




You can view and review the generated questions.





How Can I Automatically Generate a Question Bank?




Click the **Question Banks** option in the right-hand panel.




In the panel that opens, click the + icon to open the new content add menu.

Click the **Auto-Generate** option.



- •Enter a brief **description** of the questions to be generated.
- •Set the complexity level of the questions.
- •Select the number of questions.
- •Change the output language from the Advance Options section.
- •Click Select Course Items to use specific course materials as context to support the content of the questions.




You can choose from different question types.
