Description of activities	<p>The aim for this placement is to provide the possibility of teaching English as a foreign language for adults professionals, e.g. nursing teachers/researchers and administrative staff , in a Higher Institution, whose main language is Portuguese. These professionals need to learn English for eventual teaching lectures and administrative contacts outside Portugal.</p> <p>The aim of this placement is to provide the opportunity of teaching English as a foreign language to adult professionals, e.g.nursing teachers/researchers and administrative staff, in an institution of higher education whose main language is Portuguese. These professionals need to learn English for the eventual ability to use in teaching lectures and for administrative contacts outside of Portugal.</p> <p>The intention is to create groups of approximately 10 individuals at an Intermediate level (B1-B2). The objective of the lessons is to have the maximum number of participants solidify their base knowledge of English, enough to proceed to Level C1, or more, on the European Self Assessment Grid.</p> <p>The lessons must encourage the professionals to communicate with each other, using the structures and specific vocabulary they have learned (eg. Nursing) and to improve the four basic language skills: comprehending, speaking, reading and writing.</p> <p>Activities may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Group management, planning, preparing and delivering lessons to the defined groups, especially Nursing Teachers.</li> <li>• Preparing and setting tests, examination papers and exercises.</li> <li>• Marking and providing appropriate feedback on oral and written work.</li> <li>• Devising, writing and producing new materials.</li> <li>• Attending and contributing to training sessions.</li> </ul> <p>Lessons should emphasize role-playing and dialogue, but more formal exercises, language games and literature are also important.</p> <p>The Lessons will be supervised by an English Teacher from the</p>
